

GDC Youth Department Mission and Vision

Along with the beliefs and motto of the Main House of Worship, We have a mission and vision for the Youth Department as a whole:

Youth Mission Statement: Providing an excellent environment so that we may teach a foundation in the Word that will promote growth, commitment, and a strong Love for God.

Youth Vision: Our goal is that each child is learning according to their own personal growth and relationship with God. In order to accomplish this, we must consider that each phase in a child's life requires different attention. The focus then becomes to create different phases for each group of children as they grow, as follows:

Phase 1:

Foundational Teaching – In this phase is for all those that need to understand our Christian history. We achieve this by teaching the basics of the Word Of God by exploring each book of the Bible in its entirety. Taking them on a path into the lives of others that went before us and showing who God is to us.

Phase 2:

Deeper Depths – For kids that want a deeper understanding, walk, and desire of God. The children will then be taught a little more in-depth to the Word of God according to the structure and belief system of the Main House, Greater Dreams. There will be a core curriculum followed as well as the child must gain permission from their parents to attend this class. Parents will know what is being taught in this class and upon approval, may at any time request to sit in the classroom after a background check is given.

Phase 3: This phase has not been implemented during my time as Youth Ministry Coordinator
Discipleship – This is when we know that children have the basics down and has gone through the other 2 phases, whether they have been taught at home or by us. They will be tested to see where they are in their growth before going through this phase.
The kids that have tested accordingly will then be taken on a ONE on ONE journey with a proven and tested group of mature saints that will then disciple them for more growth in their walk with God. Parents MUST give permission in order for children to be disciplined as well as the person assigned to them MUST work with parents in disciplining the children.

NO ONE will be allowed to counsel these children WITHOUT the safety, permission, and knowledge of their parents. Parents WILL know everything that is being shared BEFORE they are allowed to share with each child. ANYONE violating this rule will IMMEDIATELY be dismissed from being the Disciples teacher.
